Sub: Scrutinizer's Report on Postal Ballot Voting Process and E-Voting Process conducted Pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') read with Rule 22 and Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014

The Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 has appointed me as Scrutinizer for conducting the postal ballot voting process.

I submit my report as under;

- The company has completed on 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 the dispatch / sending of emails of Notice of Postal Ballot dated 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2014, Postal Ballot Form along with postage prepaid business reply envelopes to its Members whose name(s) appeared on the Register of Members / List of Beneficiaries as on 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2014.
- 2. Particulars of all the Postal Ballots Forms received including the votes casted through e-voting from/by the Members have been entered in a Register separately maintained for the purpose.
- 3. The postal ballots were kept under safe custody in sealed and tamper proof ballot box before commencing the scrutiny of such Postal Ballot Forms.
- 4. At 10.15 a.m. on 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2014, I have downloaded the e-voting Report from CDSL website by using the Scrutinizer's login ID and Password.
- 5. The ballot box was opened on 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 at 10.30 a.m. in the presence of Two Witnesses not in the employment of the Company.
- 6. The postal ballots forms were duly opened in my presence and scrutinized. The shareholding was matched / confirmed with the Register of Members of the Company as on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2014.
- 7. All postal ballot forms received / votes casted upto the close of the working hours (on 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 up to 6.00 p.m.), the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of the ballot forms / e-voting were considered for scrutiny.
